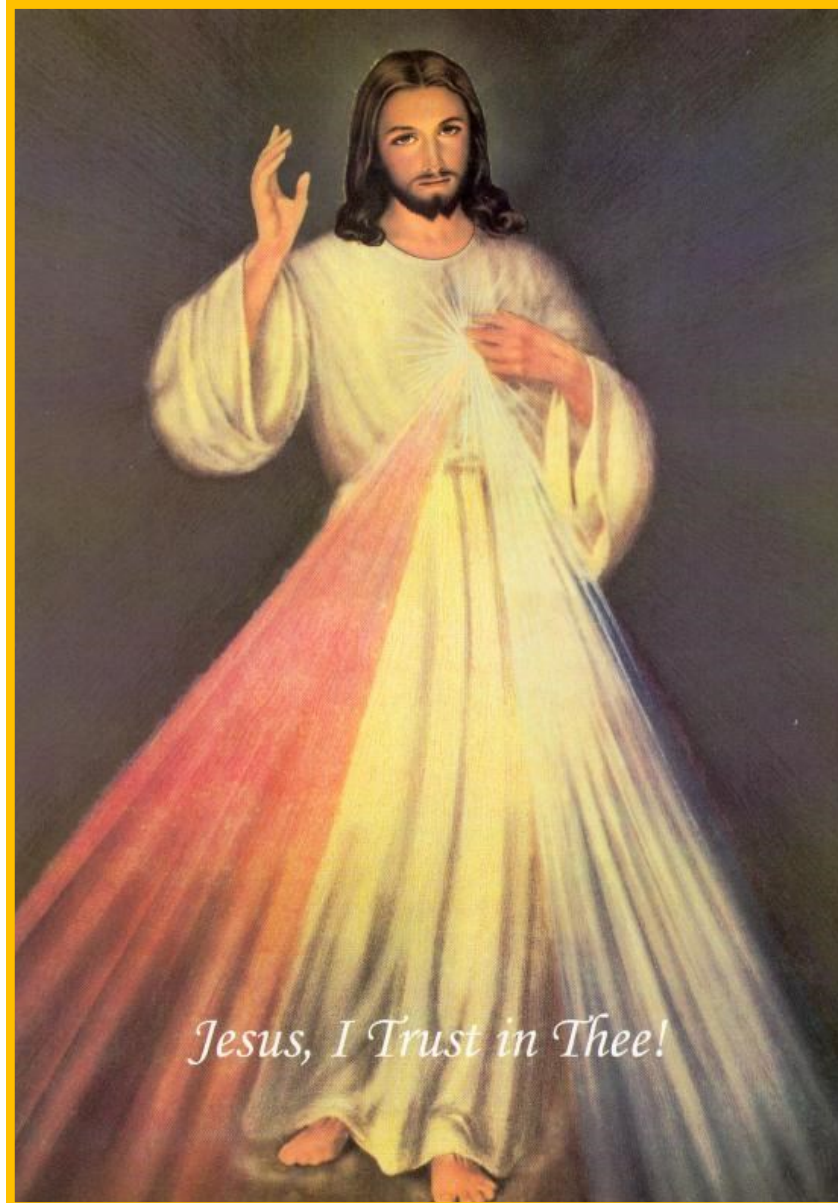

# Divine Mercy Sunday

April 11, 2021

This is an extraordinary opportunity to receive complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.

Our Lord Jesus said to St. Faustina, *“The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet... Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.”* (diary 699)

The requirements for gaining a plenary indulgence are: the exclusion of all attachment to sin, even venial sin, the performance of the indulgenced work (doing an act of mercy) and fulfillment of the three conditions: sacramental confession (within a week before or after), receive Holy Communion, and prayer for the pope's intentions. The condition requiring prayer for the pope's intentions is satisfied by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary for his intentions.

To observe the Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday:

1. Celebrate the Feast on the Sunday after Easter
2. Sincerely repent of all sins
3. Go to Confession, preferably prior to Divine Mercy Sunday
4. Place complete trust in Jesus
5. Receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast
6. Venerate the Image of The Divine Mercy
7. Be merciful to others, through our actions, works and prayers on their behalf. Practice the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy.
